



FLORIDA ENERGY SYSTEMS CONSORTIUM SUMMIT September 28-29, 2010 Orlando, Florida FESC FELLOWSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

The Florida Energy Systems Consortium (FESC) was created by the Florida State government to promote collaboration among the energy experts at its 11 supported universities to share energy-related expertise. The consortium assists the state in the development and implementation of an environmentally compatible, sustainable, and efficient energy strategic plan. The Consortium was charged to “*perform research and development on innovative energy systems that lead to alternative energy strategies, improved energy efficiencies, and expanded economic development for the state.*” Overarching to the Consortium’s research strategy is a systems approach to identify innovation opportunities, prepare an energy workforce, and guide economic development. The **FESC Summit** showcases pioneering research, education and outreach programs that focus on Florida’s sustainable energy future. The program features internationally renowned speakers, as well as presentations and posters highlighting FESC’s innovative work leading to alternative energy strategies, improved energy efficiencies, and expanded economic development for Florida. The technical program will include a round table discussion on a timely topic for Florida, as well as a Poster Overview session.

FESC FELLOWS are individuals who are interested in attending the FESC Summit on September 28-29. **This FESC Fellowship is valued at over \$200.** The Fellowship includes (1) **Conference Registration (\$50)** for conference sessions on September 28-29 (includes lunch on both days); (2) **Two nights lodging (\$150)** at the La Quinta UCF, arriving September 27 and departing September 29, and mileage to and from the event. (Lodging will **not** be provided for Fellows who live within 50 miles of the Summit at the UCF Student Union, Orlando, FL.). **Fellowship travel will be covered on a reimbursement basis. Summit registration will be paid for directly by FESC.**

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Faculty in community or state colleges who teach courses in the sciences or technologies above.
2. Submit signed application for agreeing to participate in post conference surveys and feedback.

By accepting a FESC Fellowship, the Fellow or Fellow’s institution agrees to pay any additional meals and incidentals associated with attending the FESC Summit, and any additional lodging beyond the nights specified above.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS: Upon acceptance as a Fellow:

2. Make your hotel reservations by **September 3, 2010 following directions on <http://www.floridaenergy.ufl.edu/>**. If eligible for hotel rooms, FESC will ONLY reimburse for Tuesday and Wednesday nights (9/27 and 9/28). Any additional nights as well as incidentals are not covered.
3. **Attend the entire two-day FESC Summit September 28-29.**
4. **Complete** all required conference and session evaluations for the conference and individual sessions.
