TRAINING FOR THE MANUFACTURING INDUSTRY

Are you interested in achieving a national accreditation for your manufacturing competencies? Skill certification improves your promotability, making you a more valuable employee. The Corporate College at Polk State College can offer you and your employer a unique opportunity for you to participate in a special pilot program offering of the Banner Manufacturing Essentials curriculum.

PSC Corporate College is participating with Hillsborough Community College and the Banner Center for Manufacturing in a federal Department of Labor grant to create a technology-based learning version (using a hybrid approach blending classroom instruction with e-Learning elements) of the highly successful Banner Manufacturing Essentials curriculum, with the opportunity to earn the nationally recognized Manufacturing Skill Standards Council (MSSC) Certified Production Technician (CPT) Certification. By attending this pilot class, you can also earn your OSHA 10-hour Safety Certificate at the same time.

BANNER MANUFACTURING ESSENTIALS

For this special program, the Manufacturing Essentials curriculum is a 72 Contact-hour program. The program consists of five units:

- Workplace Essentials
- Safety Awareness (MSSC exam)
- Production and Processes (MSSC exam)
- Maintenance Awareness (MSSC exam)
- Quality Assurance (MSSC exam)



Participants will be given the MSSC assessment exams on the units noted above. A certificate is awarded for each unit exam, and with passage of all four MSSC unit exams, candidates are awarded the nationally accredited MSSC CPT certification. As an added benefit, the MSSC CPT certification can be used to articulate 15 credit hours into the Engineering Technology AS degree at Polk State College.

This course is a pilot test of updated curriculum related to HCC's U.S. Department of Labor grant and the Banner Center for Manufacturing. Since it is a technology-based-learning course, participants should be computer literate prior to participation in the class.

The class will begin on Tuesday, February 23, 2010, in Room 102 at the PSC JD Alexander Center campus, located at 152 E. Central Ave. in Lake Wales. The class will meet Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 5:30 PM to 9:30 PM for nine weeks.
