Award	Criteria
Manufacturing Post-Secondary Educator-of-the-Year	A community college or technical school educator who has: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> made outstanding contributions to manufacturing and/or engineering technology. demonstrated an impact on technology education at local and state levels. demonstrated originality of ideas and techniques in manufacturing education.
Manufacturing Secondary Educator-of-the-Year	A secondary school educator who has: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> made outstanding contributions to manufacturing and/or engineering technology education. demonstrated an impact on technology education at local and state levels.
Industry Distinguished Service	A key member from industrial personnel who has: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> contributed significantly in promoting technology and career awareness in support of manufacturing. demonstrated an impact on technology education on both a local and state level through an exceptional devotion of time, effort, thought and action.
